HORTICULTURE Judge: Mr Peter Read

Flowers:

Classes 1 to 7 are for vases of Daffodils

*Please note that all Classes referring to **daffodils** could equally refer to **narcissi**.*

- 1 Trumpet flower, 1 variety, 3 stems *the trumpet should be as long/longer than the petals*
- 2 Single flower, 1 variety, 3 stems *the cup (trumpet) should be shorter than the petals.*
- 3 Double flower, 1 variety, 3 stems *the cup (trumpet) should be shorter than the petals.*
- 4 Multi-headed, 1 variety, 3 stems
- 5 Small flowered, 1 variety, 3 stems

Novice Classes (for Members who have not won a 1st in any flower class in previous BDHA shows)

- 6 Daffodil, 1 variety, 3 stems
- 7 Small flowered, 1 variety, 3 stems

Intermediate Classes (for Members who have won three 1st prizes or fewer in flower classes in previous BDHA shows)

- 8 Vase of Tulips, any variety/varieties, 3 stems
- 9 Specimen flower from any other bulb/corm
- 10 Vase of Polyanthus or Primrose, 3 stems
- 11 Vase of Primrose, 3 stems
- 12 Camelia, 1 stem
- 13 One stem of a flowering shrub
- 14 3 flower heads of Helleborus, shown floating in water
- 15* Bowl/pot of growing Daffodils max size of pot 250mm /10inches
- 16* Bowl/pot of growing Any other bulb/corm max size of pot 250mm /10inches

Vegetables and Fruit

- 17 Onions, 3
- 18 Shallots 3
- 19 Leeks 3
- 20 Rhubarb, shown with leaves, 3 sticks
- 21 Any fresh garden vegetable not included above
- 22 Any stored vegetable not included above
- 23 Any stored fruit
- 24 6 Chitted potatoes in an egg carton
- 25 Tray of pricked-out flower seedlings—minimum of 20 plants
- 26 Tray of pricked-out vegetable seedlings—minimum of 20 plants
- 27 Collection of herbs, 4 varieties, stems in water
- 28 **Growing Competition**, sponsored by The Gardens Group: 2 bulbs growing in a pot

LIDS AND JARS FOR PRESERVES

For jams and other preserves, you MAY use any plain lid—that is, a lid with no branding and displaying no words, numbers or letters of any kind. You may use plain white, black or gold lids, and those with a chequered pattern as long as they comply with the stated rule. Cellophane covers are not allowed.

Jars must be round and completely plain - that is, with no 'corners' or any other distinguishing marks.

Please ensure that the date on which you made your preserve is shown on the label.

- 35 Apricot & Walnut Slices, 4 pieces *(See Spring Show Recipe sheet)*
